

Fill out this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for the following amounts on Form TD1NL, *2017 Newfoundland and Labrador Personal Tax Credits Return*.

Do not give your filled out worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

Line 2 of Form TD1NL – Age amount

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2017, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$31,405 and \$69,612, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 6 of Form TD1NL – Spouse or common-law partner amount

If your spouse or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year (including the income earned before and during the marriage or common-law relationship) will be between \$734 and \$8,070, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Your spouse or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year			-	2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$7,336, if negative, enter "0")				3
Enter this amount on line 6 of Form TD1NL.	=			3

Line 7 of Form TD1NL – Amount for an eligible dependant

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$734 and \$8,070, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Your eligible dependant's estimated net income for the year			-	2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$7,336, if negative, enter "0")				3
Enter this amount on line 7 of Form TD1NL.	=			3

Line 8 of Form TD1NL – Caregiver amount

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$13,933 and \$16,784 calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$2,851, if negative, enter "0")			=	3
Enter the amount you claimed for this dependant on line 7 of Form TD1NL.			-	4
Line 3 minus line 4 (if negative, enter "0")				5
Enter this amount on line 8 of Form TD1NL.	=			5

Line 9 of Form TD1NL – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NL. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$6,127 and \$8,978, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$2,851, if negative, enter "0")			=	3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of Form TD1NL for this dependant.			-	4
